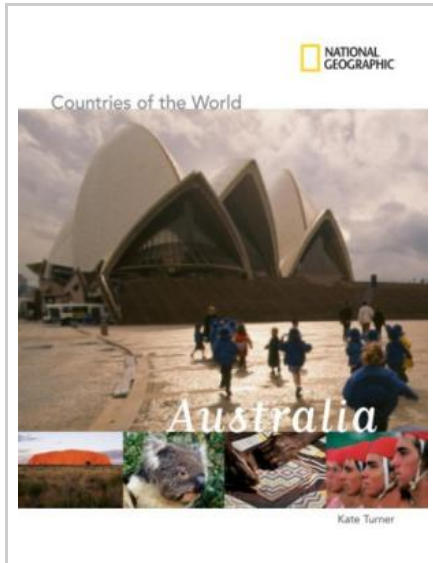




National Geographic Countries of the World: Australia (Hardback)
